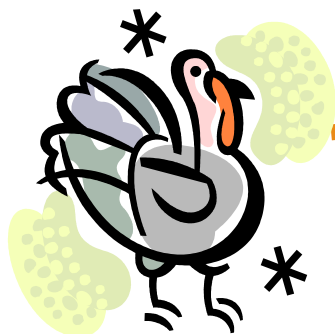

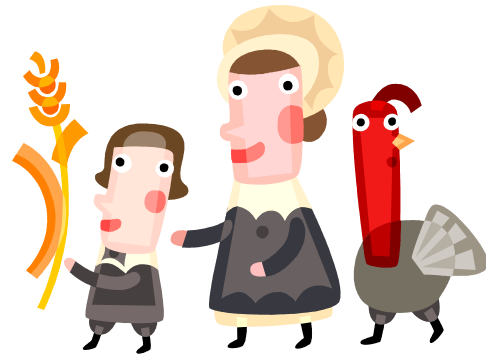
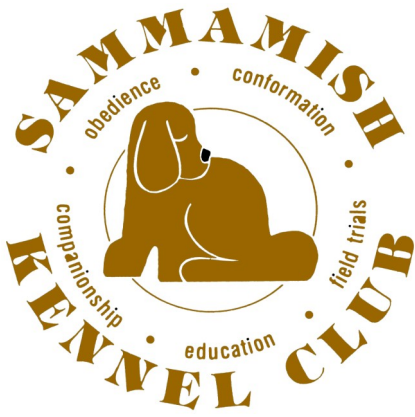
REPORT FROM THE GSP FIELD TRIAL HELD IN EURKA, KANSAS

Directions to Kirkland Fire Station 22



DRIVING DIRECTIONS: From I-405

Northbound:

Take Exit 17 onto 116th Ave. NE, turn left. Go one block to NE 70th Place, turn left over the freeway, heading toward Lake Washington:

From I-405 Southbound:

Take Exit 17, turn left on NE 72nd Place, (NE 72nd Place becomes NE 68th Street), heading toward Lake Washington:

Continue west on NE 70th Pl., (which becomes NE 72nd Pl., then becomes NE 68th Street within a few blocks) to 108th Avenue NE. This is a 4-way traffic light intersection. Turn left; go ½ block to Station 22, turn left and drive to the rear parking area.
