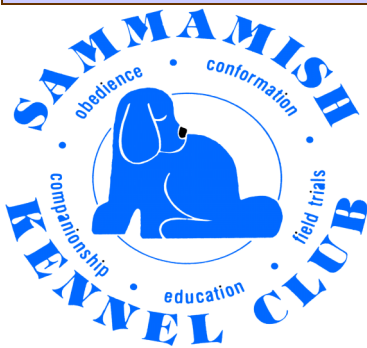

47 Trailers have been donated across the country thanks to donations from AKC Clubs, AKC Reunite, pet lovers and local municipalities. The AKC Pet Disaster Relief trailer is stocked with essential supplies to house at least 65 pets the critical first few days after a disaster is declared. The trailer has lighting and is wired for electricity to run off either a generator or 110v power supply. Along with a generator there are crates, pet carriers, bowls, collars and leashes, microchips, a microchip scanner, fans, cleaning supplies, maintenance equipment, administrative supplies, training materials and much more on the trailer to allow emergency personnel to put together co-location or lost-and-found pet shelters.

From everyone at the college, you have our sincerest thanks for your continued generous support.

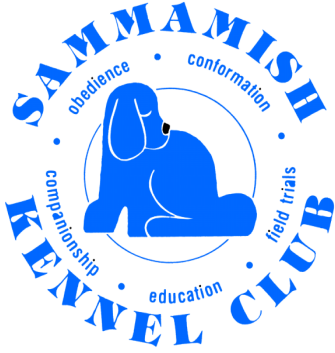
